# THE IMPORTANT OF WARRI WITHIN THE CONTEXT OF NIGER DELTA'S DEVELOPMENT

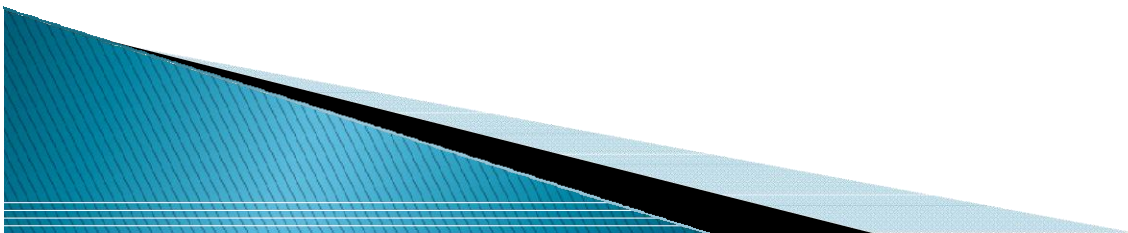
*Warri Town is in Delta South Senatorial District.*

*It has a unique history that has not been documented well enough by historians. The name Warri province was once applicable to the part of an area now called Delta State under the Colony and Protectorate of Southern Nigeria.*

*Its boundary in the north east was Nsukwa/Isheagu creek near Warri city is one of the major hubs of petroleum activities and Kwale and Aboh, Forcados River in the south east and Jamieson businesses in the southern Nigeria.*

*Creek in the south west and later changed to Delta Province.*

*The city is one of cosmopolitan cities in southern Nigeria, comprising originally of Itsekiri, Urhobo and Ijaw people. Warri is predominantly Christian with mixture of African traditional religions like most of the Southern Nigeria. The city is known nationwide for its unique Pidgin English.*



# WHY WARRI SHOULD BE MASSIVELY DEVELOP

*Warri is the commercial headquarters of Delta State  
It is an industrial hub, due to the strategic location of  
the city's sea within the flank of the "ungovernable  
territory", being the Gulf of Guinea, a potential that  
can be tapped with enormous maritime opportunities*

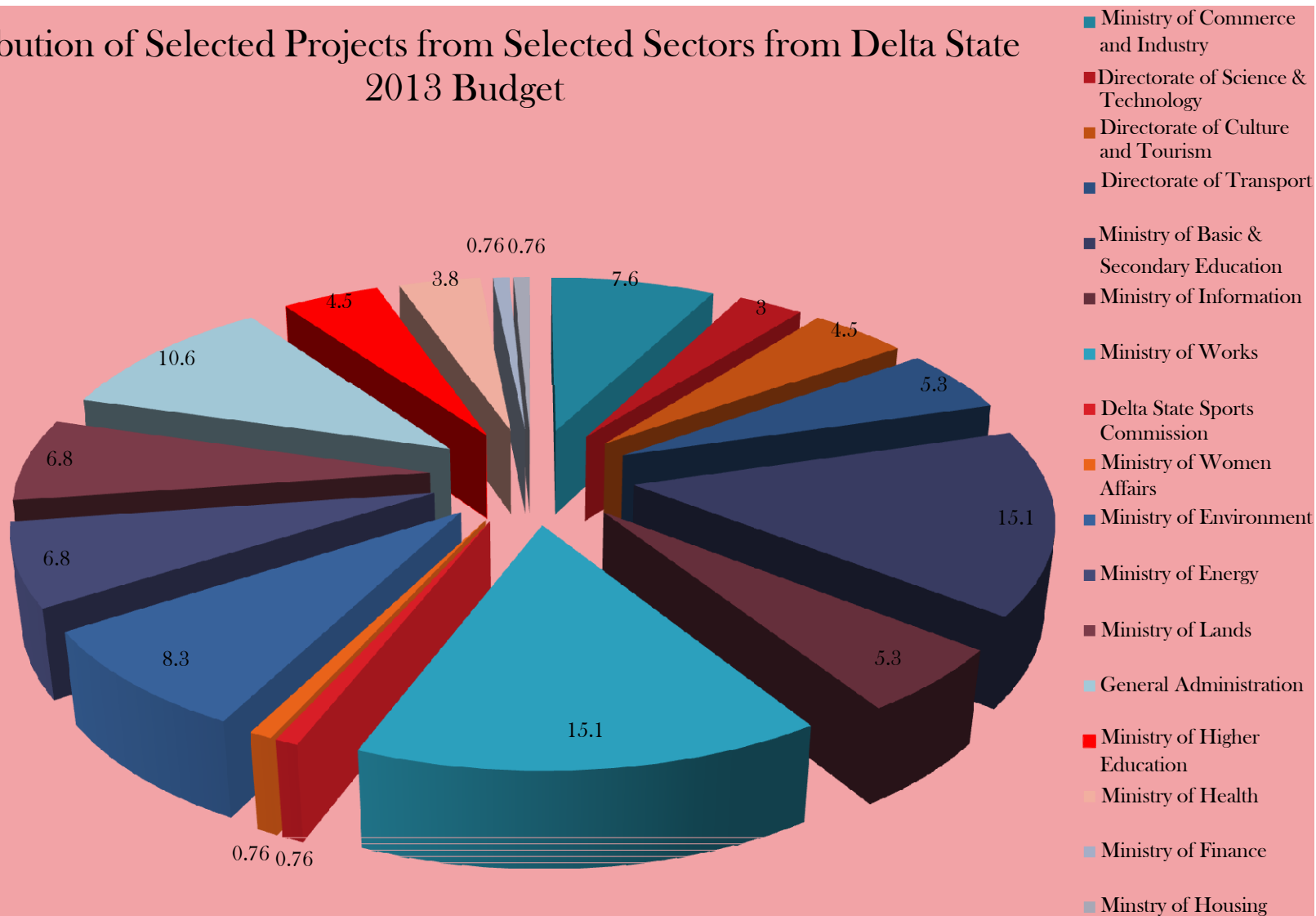
*Warri is an important Oil Producing Cluster with a  
refinery to cap it off  
through the Warri Harbour*

*It has a potential for igniting conflicts, hence the  
youths within the Cluster should be meaningfully

Cluster without communal peace. Let there be peace!*

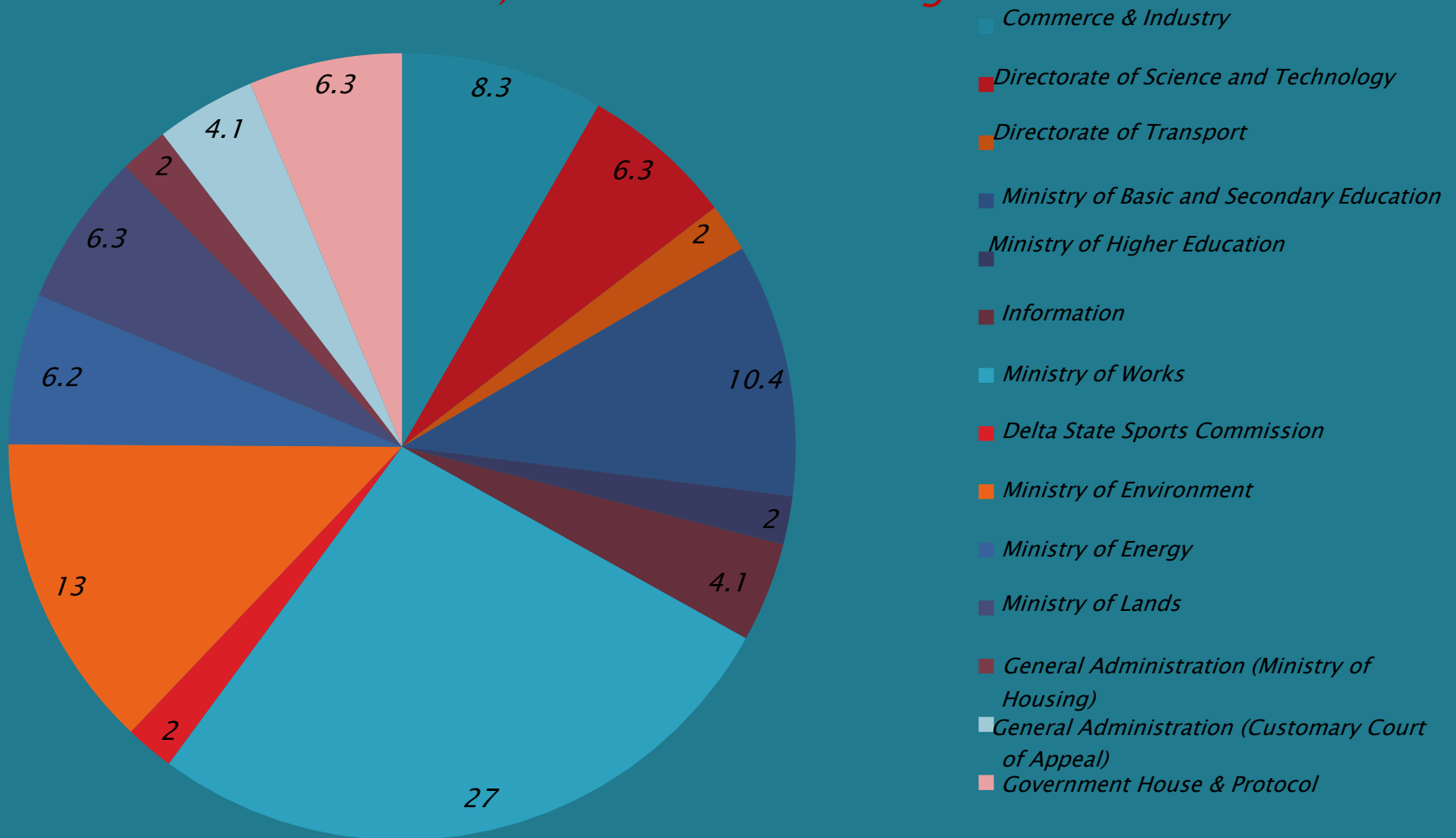
# SECTORAL DISTRIBUTION OF DELTA STATE PROJECTS 2013 EXTRACTED (SECTOR SPECIFIC)

## CONT...SOME PROJECTS SPECIFIC FOR WARRI

*Canalization of Baternren-Tselu-Utanoyibo Creek in Warri-South LGA for N150 million, Construction of Engineering Workshop in University of Petroleum for N100 million, Signaling and Communication Equipment (Ajaokuta- Warri Rail Line) for N1.4 billion, Engineering design for the Rehabilitation of Bomadi-Warri Road in Delta State N160 million, Special Repairs of Critical Failed Sections of Effurun Roundabout- Warri Old Port Harcourt- Warri Township Road at N150.7 million, Dualization of East-West Road (Sections 1-4) Warri-Kajama) 8.7km at N7.7 billion, Shoreline Protection/ Land Reclamation at Okorutip-Ibena LGA, Okoroette/ Okoroji River State: Ijaghalla (Warri South/West LGA, Bomadi Waterfront, Bomadi Mbokho/ Okoroitti, Eastern Obolo LGA, Akwa-Ibom State, Anyama, Ogbia LGA, Delta State: Awoye West Ward Phase 1, Seluwa Westward, Abereke Westward, Ondo State: Obuama, Degema LGA, Rivers State and other existing studied sites in nine Niger Delta States at N100 million. Others are; Construction of Officers and Airmen Accommodation in Yenagoa, Sokoto, Warri and Port Harcourt (By Direct Labour) at N501 million by Federal Ministry of Defence, Construction of 4 Units of 3 Classroom Block with VIP toilets at Ogheye Primary School (Eghoroke Town), Warri North LGA at N60 million etc,*
